


A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT:

Music Miles Guidelines Swift Current Band Parents' Auxiliary

The Music Mile system provides all band families with a variety of ways to offset the complete or partial cost of band trips.

How are Music Miles earned? Music Miles can be earned through fundraising projects, which will be placed into one of three categories:

- 1. <u>Participation Projects</u> by volunteering their time to assist with these fundraisers, workers will receive an established number of MUSIC MILES according to the following schedule:
 - Beef and Band Blast: All volunteers 1 Music Mile per 45min shift
 - <u>Bottle Drive</u>:
 - ➢ Drivers 4 Music Miles per route (completed with minimum 2 route walkers)
 - Sorters 4 Music Miles for a complete shift (3 4 hrs)
 - ➤ Walkers 2 Music Miles per route (completed)
 - <u>Sweet Treats</u>: 1 Music Mile per shift (2 hrs)
 - <u>Grilling Meats</u>: 1 Music Mile per shift (2 hrs)

* From time to time, individuals <u>not</u> involved with the Comp Band may work at "participation" fundraisers. One example of this would be Bottle Drives, when a student may enlist relatives or graduated siblings to assist with a route. In these situations, the worker(s) must clearly indicate the surname of the family that will receive their Music Miles. This information is collected by the Fundraiser Task Leader.

2. <u>Profit Unit Projects</u> – Students will receive a cash value amount based on a calculation of profit units generated, less any fundraiser expenses. Our profit unit fundraisers for this year are Sweet Treats and Grilling Meats.

- 3. <u>Administration</u> Music Miles can also be earned through parent participation on the Band Auxiliary Executive, or by being a Fundraiser Task Leader or Administrative Task Leader. Workers will receive an established number of Music Miles for participating, according to the following schedule:
 - President, Treasurer and Music Miles
 - Vice President and Secretary
